



World AIDS Campaign 2023

In support of World AIDS Day, Red Ribbon Centre (RRC) has arranged a HIV Testing Service promotion vehicle themed "For your health, Get tested" to visit various locations in Hong Kong in December to raise public awareness of AIDS, promote HIV testing services and appeal to the public to care about people living with AIDS.

Featuring cartoons and games, the promotion vehicle enlightens the public about the mode of transmission and preventive measures of HIV, and promotes the importance of HIV testing in an interesting way.










The promotion vehicle also showcases DH's new HIV Testing Service website (www.hivtest.gov.hk). In addition to the existing feature to make reservations of AIDS Counselling and Testing Service (ACTS), the new website provides an enhanced function for ordering HIV self-test kits, so as to promote HIV testing, the gateway to treatment, prevention and care, essential to achieve "the first 95" of the United Nations' 95-95-95 targets.



Gay Games Hong Kong 2023 & Hong Kong Pride Parade 2023

On 10 November 2023, Red Ribbon Centre (RRC) hosted a booth at the Festival Village of a large-scale LGBT event "Gay Game Hong Kong 2023" held in the AIA Vitality Park. Visitors to the booth could participate in interactive games and activities designed to teach them facts about HIV/AIDS while debunking common misconceptions.





On 18 November 2023, RRC hosted a booth at "Hong Kong Pride Parade 2023", a significant LGBT event held in the Wave, to promote safer sex practices and raise awareness about the concept of U=U (Undetectable equals Untransmittable). A total of 510 condoms and over 400 giveaway items were distributed.
