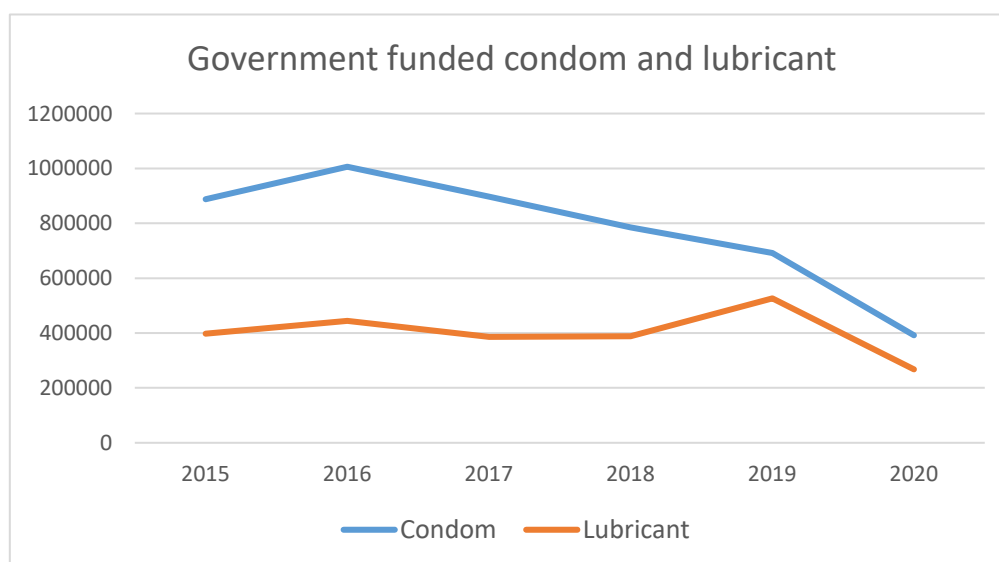

Partnership with LGBT communities and Department of Health

- "Hong Kong Lesbian and Gay Film Festival"- In collaboration with Hong Kong Lesbian and Gay Film Festival Society, DH started supporting the screening of AIDS related gay movies and organizing HIV prevention activities since 2006.
- "Hong Kong Pride Parade"- To extend a wider coverage of health promotion, DH first joined the Parade in 2012. Health messages are conveyed through various kinds of activities such as condom mascots marching and booth games etc.
- "Pink Dot Hong Kong"- DH joined the event in 2016. Since it is a large LGBT platform, health messages on the HIV prevention and safer sex can reach large number of people through this event.
