The 18th International AIDS Conference was held in Vienna, Austria from 18-23 July 2010. The theme of the Conference was "Rights Here, Right Now".

Prof CHEN Char-nie, ACA Chairman, Dr Samuel YU, member of the Council for the AIDS Trust Fund and Ms Gipsy CHANG, member of the Red Ribbon Centre Management Advisory Committee together with members of non-governmental organizations as well as representatives from government departments attended the Conference. A Report Back Seminar of the 18th International AIDS Conference was held on 29 September 2010 at the Lecture Theatre of the Public Health Laboratory Centre. The purpose of the seminar was to let the conference attendees share with the audience the experiences and insights they learned from the conference. A total of 106 participants attended the seminar.

To kick off the seminar, Professor CHEN, the Chairman of ACA gave a speech on science based drug policy followed by the presentation given by Dr YU, on funding on prevention.

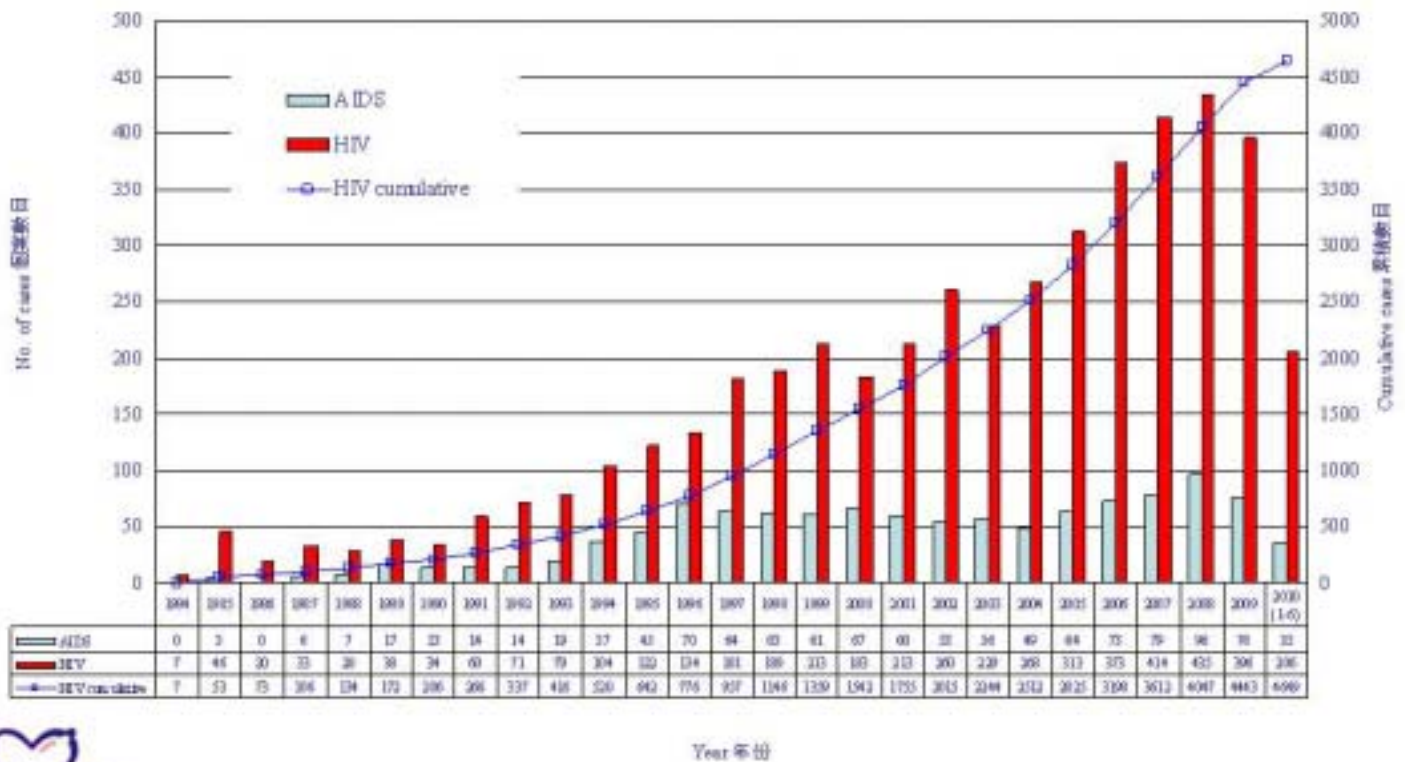

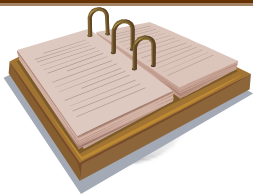
## Annual HIV/AIDS Statistics
