# Schema of operation for the Hong Kong Advisory Council on AIDS (2014-2017)


The operation of ACA in its new term (August 2014 – July 2017) were discussed during the 88th ACA Meeting held on 10 October 2014, and agreed as follows -

- (a) The terms of reference (TOR), objectives, overall strategies, operation, and role of the ACA secretariat remained unchanged;
- (b) The ACA Chairperson and eight serving members of the last term had been reappointed for three years (one serving member was re-appointed for two years upon request). Balancing flexibility and stability for the future ACA, all new members would be appointed for two years starting from this term, eligible for reappointment; and
- (c) The two-tier system of ACA and the Community Forum on AIDS (CFA) would continue. The TOR of CFA (2011-2014) were slightly amended to reflect that stakeholders not directly involved in HIV/AIDS but in related fields were also included in the CFA platform for dialogue. Professor Samuel YU, the serving CFA Convener, was re-appointed for the new term and he would be invited to attend ACA Meetings in the capacity of CFA Convener.

ACA members were invited to join CFA as Member, or attend individual CFA Meeting / particular agenda item of interest on a voluntary basis.


Familiarization visits to NGOs and government units working on HIV/AIDS would be arranged in the coming months.
