# A Summary of the 46th CFA Meeting held on 8 March 2018

Preliminary result of PRiSM 2017 - Men who have sex with men (MSM) / male-to-female transgender (TGW)

DH presented and highlighted the preliminary result of PRiSM 2017. A total of 4,133 MSM and 104 TGW respondents participated in the survey. The overall HIV prevalence for sexually active MSM and active TGW was estimated to be 6.54% and 5.11% respectively. Major findings of the survey including demographics, HIV status, social networking, sexual behaviour, drug/substance use, exposure to HIV prevention messages, HIV testing behaviour, self-reported history of sexually transmitted illnesses, use of HIV pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) among MSM and TGW were presented. Members noted the preliminary results of the study. Publicity of relevant health messages arising from the survey would be discussed further.

#### **Update on HIV situation (2017)**

DH updated members on the HIV situation of 2017. There were a total of 681 HIV cases and 91 AIDS cases reported to DH in 2017. Cumulatively, DH received 9,091 HIV reports and 1,857 AIDS cases as of 2017. The number of HIV reports decreased slightly by about 1.6% this year as compared with 2016.

# Results of internal audit on HIV voluntary counselling and testing services (VCT) in community settings 2016

DH presented the results of internal audit on HIV voluntary counselling and testing services (VCT) in community settings 2016. This audit is based on a checklist devised by DH, to be used by individual NGO as part of its quality assurance activities. Members noted the results and were reminded to take note of several issues at organization level, such as proper storage of the test kits, internal/external training to staff providing VCT services and proper record keeping of the testing results.

#### HARiS 2018 and ethnic minority survey

Members noted that forthcoming HARiS 2018 would include MSM, TGW and injecting drug user (IDU). DH would further liaise with each involving NGO to estimate the target sample size of the survey. Ethnic minority survey would be performed as a pilot study later this year tentatively, any suggestion on the methodology was welcomed.

# Training Workshop on Basic Knowledge of HIV/AIDS & STIs for NGO Staff

Two sessions of training workshop were held on 12 and 26 April 2018 and were attended by 53 NGO staff. The first session covered basic knowledge of HIV / sexually transmitted diseases and introduced DH HIV clinic / social hygiene clinic services, while the second focused on selected populations including MSM, female sex workers, chemsex users, transgender and ethnic minorities.
